Athens, September 11, 2002

The General Secretary for Development, in compliance with Ministerial Decision A.P. F90.1/1307/675/6.9.2002 of the Minister of Development, issues a Call for Tender for the provision of financial incentives for private energy investments in energy conservation/cogeneration/alternatives and renewable energy sources, with the exception of investments in independent power production from wind energy in grid connected areas of Greece and investments in projects with a power output of greater than 5 MW in non grid connected areas, through the Operational Programme “Competitiveness” of the Third Community Framework Programme.

The investments which will be approved will be those which fulfill the special terms and conditions which are referred to in detail in the “Guide to Energy Investments” published by the Ministry of Development (September, 2002). The maximum grant for each category of investment and by area of Greece is as follows:

The evaluation of the proposals for funding will be done by the Central Evaluation Committee which will be convened by a decision of the Ministry of Development in accordance with Presidential Decree 98/1996.

The proposals will be ranked on the basis of the criteria in the “Guide to Energy Investments”

The budgeted funds for projects accepted for support through the present Call for Tenders are approximately 117.387.343 Euro. These funds will be distributed, tentatively, as follows: 50% to investments which require a permit and 50% to investments which do not require a permit and these percentages may be adjusted according to investor interest.

This Call for Tender concerns projects which are funded jointly by the European Regional Development Fund, which contributes to correcting inequalities among the regions of the European Union, and the Greek Government. Investment proposals will be accepted from privately incorporated organisations, or consortia of such organisations, which do not belong to the public sector. A prerequisite for the submission of an investment proposal for funding is a permit, wherever required.

The Call for Tender will be open until 31.12.2003. Proposals must be submitted to the relevant management agencies, contact details for which are provided in the attached table.

Three (3) copies of each investment proposal must be submitted.
